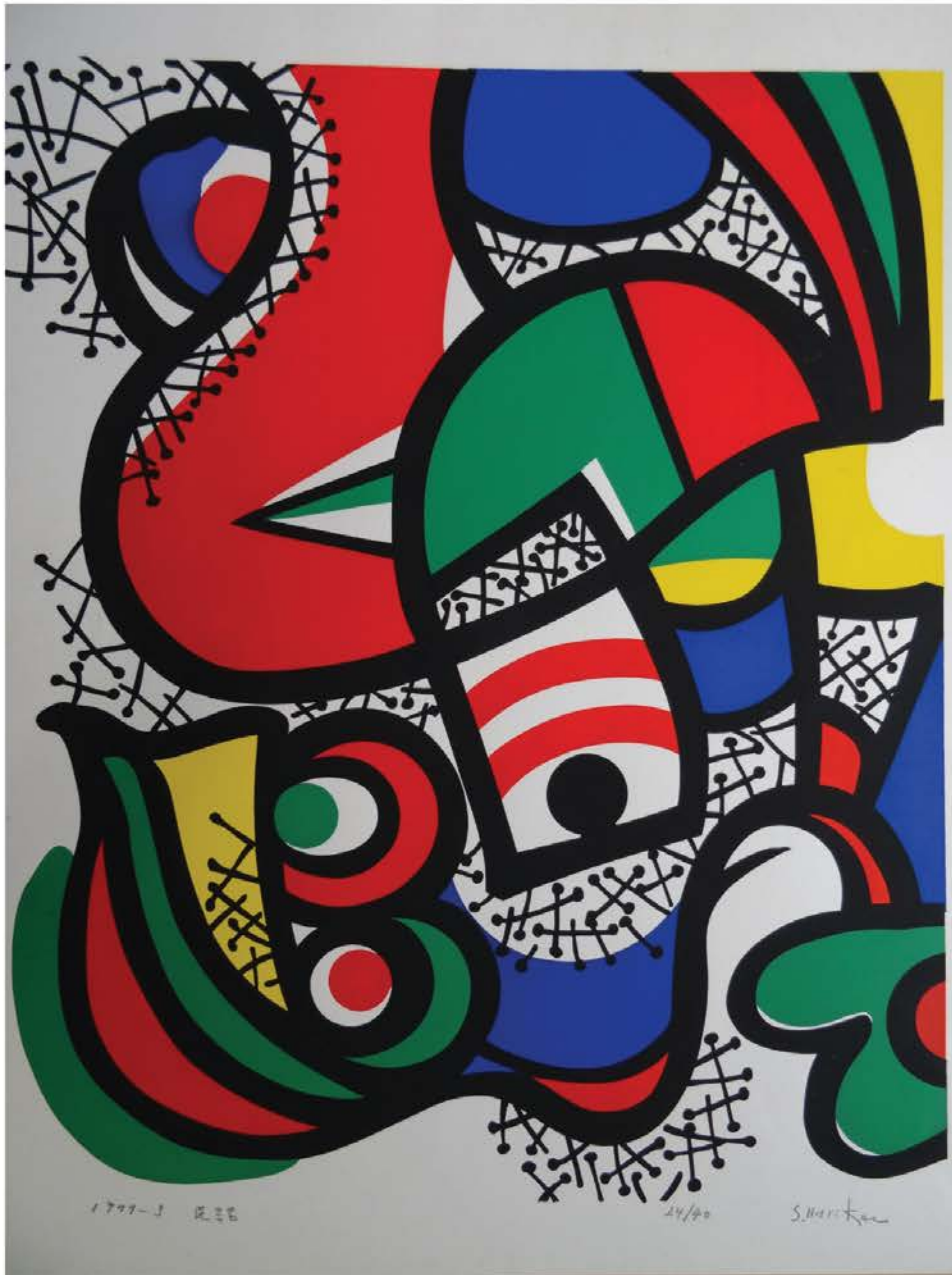

SHOJI HARIKAE (1914 - 2003)

PROFILE

1914 Born in Tokyo.

1938 Studied under Seiji Choukai.

1940 Studied at Taiheiyo Art Institute.

*Accepted at 20th Kokugakai Kaigabu Exhibition. Became a member of Atarashiki-mura Art Exhibition promoted by The Yomiuri News-papers.

1949 Exhibited at Yomiuri Independent Exhibition.

1950 Invited to exhibit at Rengo Exhibition promoted by The Mainichi Newspapers.

1954 Released a series of social satire paintings titled "birds".

1954, 55, 60, 61, 62, 63, 64, 65, 66, 68, 69, 70 Held one-person exhibition at Shinbashi Mimatsu Gallery, Tokyo.

1957 Nominated to the Yomiuri Independent Exhibition committee.

1959 Nominated to the Kokugakai committee.

1960 Accepted at a prints contest hosted by Charles E. Tuttle.

1963 Accepted at Kokugakai Print Exhibition. Nominated to the Kokugakai general affair committee.

1964 Won the Prize at Kokugakai's Print Exhibition.

1965 Made a contract with Furannel Gallery on oil paintings as Painter of Green.

1967 Participated in Sweden 30-person Oil Paintings Traveling Exhibition.

1971 Invited to exhibit at Ibaragi Prefecture Excellent Work Art Exhibition.

1972 Exhibited at Kokugakai Prints Exhibition promoted by Central Art Exhibition.

1974 Exhibited at East Germany Prints Exhibition. First travel to Spain.

1976 Invited to exhibit at Ibaragi Prefecture Excellent Work Art Exhibition.

1980 Won the medal with a Dark Navy Blue Ribbon by recommendation of Tochigi Prefectural Museum of Fine Arts. A Kokugakai Exhibition entry, "Eguru", appeared on Asahi Journal.

1983 The Kokugakai Exhibition entry, "Sasaeru", appeared on Shinano Newspaper.

1984 Held a one-person old print exhibition at Toho Gallery. Invited to exhibit at Contemporary Art Exhibition at Ibaragi Prefectural Art Museum.

1985 Exhibited at 4 Contemporary Artists(Shousuke Osawa, Tatsuoki Nanbata, Masanari Murai, and Shoji Harikae) Exhibition at Art Play Gallery.

1992 Exhibited at Machida International print Museum titled "Post war Prints".

1993 Exhibited at Gankouji-temple in Nara prefecture.

1998 Exhibited at Art Forum Exhibition, titled "Mainly 1960' s ." Held a lecture, titled "My World" , at Tokyo Metropolitan Art Forum Yanaka, Tokyo.

2001 Especially exhibited 15 works of "My World" at 75th Kokugakai Memorial Exhibition.

* Won the medal with a Dark Blue Ribbon by recommendation of Shinshu Takato Art Museum.
